### III. World Ambassadors at UGA Monetary Allocation Request

- World Fest – Tate Plaza, 11:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
  - World Fest is a kickoff for International Education week
  - Includes a student activity fair that features over 30 organizations
  - Allocation Request of \$400 for food purchases
    - Will use allocation to provide funds to featured organizations to buy food.
  - RHA logo on flyers and the ability to table at the event
  - Anticipated 250-400 attendees
- Discussion

  - Motion to move allocation to \$200

    - Motion passes and discussion continues at \$200
  - Call to question
    - Dissent: “More discussion needed”
      - In favor of continuing discussion at \$200
        - i. 8
      - Against
        - 22
    - Call to question passes
      - In favor of allocating \$200
        - i. 26
      - Against
        - i. 4
      - Abstain
        - i. 0
  - Allocation is passed at \$200
