I. Roll Call

II. UGA Spikeball Club Allocation Presentation

- UGA Spikeball Club
  - One of the first spikeball collegiate sport clubs
  - Meets every Friday at 4:30 PM on Myers Quad
  - Open to all UGA students regardless of level of experience
- 2016 Spikeball Club Fall Tournament
  - Set for November 5th, 2016
  - Will be first annual fall tournament hosted by the UGA Spikeball Club
  - Serves as club’s main fundraiser for the year
  - Free for UGA students but \$10 for non-UGA participants
- Spring Tournament 2016

- Was called “Spike for a Cause”
- Had 42 different teams participating, 84 attendees in total
- Winner was from Chicago, indicative of participants traveling to play
- Benefits for UGA Residents
  - Fun and exciting opportunity to compete and represent UGA
  - Facilitates new connections between students, both UGA and other
  - Giveaways are offered to all participants and prizes to the top five teams
    - Giveaways are free Spikeball stickers and koozies
    - Prizes can be Spikeball sets, gift cards, and t-shirts for places downtown
- Cost Analysis
  - Spikeball Sets
    - \$250
  - Refreshments
    - \$100
  - Marketing
    - \$40
  - Table & Chair Rentals
    - \$10
  - Total
    - \$400
- Allocation Request
  - Requesting an allocation of \$250 to purchase new spikeball sets
  - In return, UGA Spikeball would credit RHA as the key sponsor of the event, as well as give special recognition to RHA at the event itself
- Questions
  - Each spikeball set is around \$60 apiece, but they can get a discount, so they could get 5 more sets, which would accommodate 20 more players
  - They have tried renting sets previously, but the sets didn’t provide all the pieces, hence why they’re trying to buy the sets they need
  - Advertising will be done through flyers in residence halls and Tate, advertisement in Red and Black, posting on social media, etc.
  - The event will also be live on USA Spikeball as well
  - Advertising will be directed towards UGA students this year
  - However, around half the participants from last year were out-of-state

- Discussion
  - If RHA allocates the total request (\$250), we’d be event co-sponsors
  - The sport element would allow RHA to reach a whole new demographic of people, especially since it isn’t an exclusive sport
  - Motion to amend to \$120
    - Second seen
    - Dissent: “We wouldn’t be cosponsors anymore.”
    - Vote on dissent
      - In favor → moving back into discussion at \$250

  - Vote on dissent

  - Tie vote
    - President breaks tie → discussion continues at \$250
- If we’re not a cosponsor, there’s no point in giving them money
- Residents won’t know about it unless they advertise in residence halls
- They’d get to keep the sets, so it’d be an investment in the club itself
- The money wouldn’t be going to waste because it’s needed
- If we were co-sponsors, we’d get a better deal because of the publicity
- Others besides just Myers residents would have the opportunity to go
- Call to question at \$250

    - In favor → move back into discussion at \$250

  - Allocation passes at \$250
